Dear Parents,

We are pleased to announce that we have been able to secure a new date for our School Year 2-6 Swimming Carnival. The carnival will be held on Thursday March 19th. All other details remain the same as the previous carnival.

Children are asked to wear their sports uniform or house colours, wearing swimmers underneath their clothes. The children will also need to wear thongs/crocs and bring a re-usable bag containing their towel, fruit boost, snack, lunch and water bottle.

Competitive races will remain the same as the entries received for the original carnival. All competitive swimmers will need to be dropped off at the pool between 8:00am-8:15am with competitive races commencing at 8:30am.

The running of the carnival will be as previously informed. Buses will pick students up to return to school from 2:00pm onwards. If you would like to take your child directly home from the pool please do so after notifying your child's teacher. You can advise your child's teacher prior to the carnival or on the day. **There is no canteen available. Children will need to bring a packed lunch.**

We will still require a large amount of parent helpers on the day. You can indicate your availability for this on the return slip.
